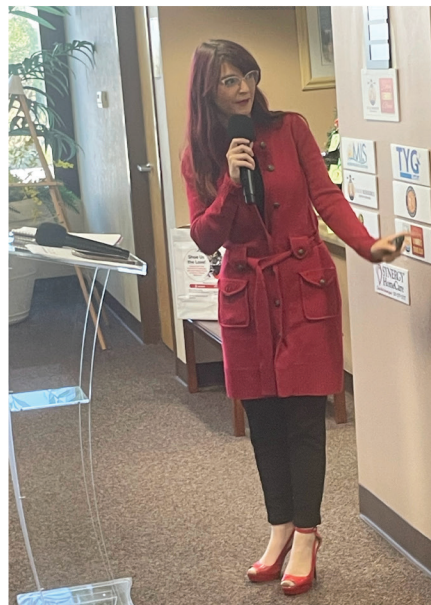
Helping Seniors and AARP Florida Present "SCAM JAM: What AI Is"

To help seniors and their families better understand this rapidly evolving landscape, Helping Seniors of Brevard and AARP Florida are presenting SCAM JAM: "What AI Is," a free educational workshop on Thursday, July 16, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Zon Beachside in Indian Harbour Beach.

The program begins with Darryl Greer of OATS/Senior Planet from AARP, who will explain what AI is, how it works, and the many ways it can improve everyday life. Darryl, who is South Regional Program Manager for the Senior Planet program, is flying in from Texas to share an overview of the Good, the Bad, and the Ugly of "What AI Is" and how it will impact our lives going forward.

Karen Civitate, AARP Florida Lead Volunteer, who share on the work of the AARP Fraud Watch Network, who is trackings how scammers are using AI in fraud schemes and share practical tips for staying safe.

Apollo Boulevard, 2nd Floor, Melbourne.

This free conference is built around the theme **"Connect. Learn. Recharge."** and is designed to equip caregivers with practical information while introducing them to local professionals and fellow caregivers who understand the challenges of the caregiving journey. Lunch is included.

The morning begins with "Caring for Yourself While Caring for Others," a discussion focused on recognizing caregiver stress, avoiding burnout, building support networks, and learning the importance of self-care.

Next, "Navigating the Caregiving Journey" explores practical strategies for managing the medical appointments, interacting communicating with the healthcare
